## CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

### Foundation Stage & Key Stage One

Spring Term 2018

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am pleased to be able to give you some further information about your child's studies this term. I have also included some general school information, which may also be helpful.

#### ENGLISH

Nursery are learning about: writing their names and model writing for familiar stories, listening to and joining in with stories, retelling and acting stories.

Reception are learning about: "Rosie's Walk" and "Whatever Next" – sequencing, writing labels, retelling using past tense, sentence structure and phonics.

Year 1 are learning about: recount lists, character adjectives, story recall and non-fiction, familiar stories. They are developing literacy skills in their history and geography work.

Year 2 are learning about: "The Snail and the Whale"- alliteration, speech marks, character feelings, rhyme and noun phrases, "Greenpeace"- letter writing, apostrophes, finding facts from texts, conjunctions, suffixes and sub-headings, "Storm Whale"- diary entries and role play, narrative poetry and setting description, imperative verbs, contents pages, similes, metaphors and paragraphs, "Grandad's Island"- adjectives, adverbs, prepositions, first person writing and changing tenses, commas, fronted adverbials and time conjunctions.

#### MATHEMATICS

Nursery are learning about: every day counting, recognising and writing numerals, measuring e.g. big/small, tall/short and recognising and naming 2D shapes.

Reception are learning about: addition and subtraction, map and directions and positional language.

Year 1 are learning about comparing measures and using "think 10" when adding and subtracting.

Year 2 are learning about: number and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, properties of shape, measurement m and cm, money, statistics, fractions, time and missing number problems.

#### SCIENCE

Nursery are learning about: "Materials" and "Looking After Animals."

Reception are learning about: "Where We Are" and "Rainforests."

Year 1 are learning about: "Weather and Seasons" and "Materials."

Year 2 are learning about: "Animals", including "Humans."

#### CROSS CURRICULAR SUBJECTS

Nursery are learning about: "Nursery Rhymes and Traditional Tales" and "Animals."

Reception are learning about: "Where We Are" and "Rainforests."

Year 1 are learning about: "Toys" and "Christopher Columbus."

Year 2 are learning about: "Explorers."

#### HOMEWORK

Foundation Stage – Home reading, phonics, simple maths and English activities.

Year 1 - Home reading, weekly spellings, handwriting activities, number facts.

Year 2 - Home reading, weekly spellings and phonics, handwriting activities, number facts and games.

**All pupils are expected to read daily, at home, and have their book signed by a parent/carer.**

*If Reading Records are lost, then these will have to be replaced at the cost of 35p each. If reading books are lost, then these will have to be replaced at a charge of £3.50.*

## CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

### Key Stage Two

Spring Term 2018

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am pleased to be able to give you some information about your child's studies this term. I have also included some general school information, which may be helpful.

#### ENGLISH

Year 3 are learning about: Comprehension Skills, Adventure Stories, Persuasive Writing, Grammar, Poetry and Plays.

Year 4 are learning about: Recounts, Inference, Sentence Punctuation, Story Planning, Fronted Adverbials, Expanded Noun Phrases and Imaginary World Stories.

Year 5 are learning about: Fantasy Stories, Poetry and Non Chronological Reports.

Year 6 are learning about: Grammar - Modal Verbs, Active and Passive Sentences, Recount Writing-WW2 Diary and Evacuee letter, Texts from English Heritage - *William Shakespeare*, Short Narrative Writing, Report writing and Persuasive/Complaint Letter Writing.

#### MATHEMATICS

Year 3 are learning about: Place Value, Symmetry/Shape, Addition & Subtraction, Division with Remainders, Fractions, Measurement (grams and kg), Geometry – Angles, Money, Measurement - Time, Column Addition and Subtraction, Statistics, Multiplication and Division Problems.

Year 4 are learning about: Multiplication and Division Facts and Written Methods for Solving Multiplication and Division Problems.

Year 5 are learning about: Problem Solving, Division, Fractions – Simplifying, Ordering and Multiplying, Converting and Equivalence, Geometry – Angles, Position and Direction, Statistics, Measurement – Converting Units, Geometry – Reflection, Translation and Coordinates, Decimals, Percentages, Time and Problem Solving- Multiplication and Division.

Year 6 are learning about: Pie Charts, Fractions - Multiplying and Dividing, Measurements -Time and Interpreting Calendars, Problem Solving – Reasoning and Statistics, Geometry, Measurement- Area and Perimeter, 2D and 3D Shapes.

#### SCIENCE

Year 3 are learning about: "Forces" and "Magnets."

Year 4 are learning about: "Solids, Liquids and Gases."

Year 5 are learning about: "Forces" and "Materials – Properties and Changes."

Year 6 are learning about: "Living Things and their Habitats" and "Light"

#### CROSS CURRICULAR SUBJECTS

Year 3 are learning about: "The United Kingdom" and "Italy."

Year 4 are learning about: "Ancient Egypt" and "Deserts."

Year 5 are learning about: "Geography – Water."

Year 6 are learning about: "World War Two."

#### HOMEWORK

Year 3 – Daily reading at home, weekly times tables, spellings and one extended piece of work.

Year 4 - Daily reading at home, weekly times tables, spellings and one extended piece of work.

Year 5 - Daily reading at home, weekly times tables, spellings and one extended piece of work.

Year 6 –Daily reading at home, weekly times tables, spellings and weekly literacy and numeracy revision work.

**All pupils are expected to read daily, at home, and have their book signed by a parent/carer.  
Homework Diaries must be signed off by a parent/carer weekly.**

If Homework Diaries, Reading Records or exercise books are lost, then these will have to be replaced at the cost of 35p each. If reading books are lost, then these will have to be replaced at a charge of £3.50.
