Thank you for your time in responding so positively to this questionnaire. All of your responses and comments have been looked at and are valued by us. They will support us in School Improvement Planning for the next 12 months to ensure that our current high standards are maintained and that identified areas for improvement are addressed.

There were a total of 155 responses this year as opposed to 263 responses last year and 44 on Parent View during our Ofsted inspection in 2014. Due to the success of handing out the questionnaire during the Spring Term Consultations we will repeat this in the future. Not all questions were answered by all parents and percentages have been rounded up or down to the nearest whole percent, therefore, row totals may not always equal 100.

Comparisons with last year's survey show that parent/carers satisfaction with the school remains high. Thank you for all of your feedback which we very much appreciate.
