He will be missed by those of us that taught him or knew him, and I know that many of you also knew him.

We are continuing to focus on behaviours for learning and our ABC's this week. Each week we introduce a new set of signs to help us all remember the classroom rules. This week we are learning about Resilience, our third whole school value, 'to help us learn we - give it a try, ask for help and enjoy learning something new'.
