Dear Parents & Carers.

This week governors visited on Wednesday and spoke to the children about behaviour and safeguarding.

They were particularly impressed with the standards of behaviour as the children move around the school and in lessons. The children were able to talk about how the new rewards and expected behaviours made them feel safe and helped them to make the right choices.

One of the things that we are introducing to further improve behaviour and learning behaviours around the school is to introduce some consistent expectations and practice around the school. This is one way that everyone can show a pride in belonging to Ashtree.

I have been speaking with children about how we move around the school. We will now be using the reminder A B C, Always quiet, Be polite, Calm body and mind. The children have been very keen to show me that they remember this and that they are putting into practice.

Something else which supports children's behaviour are consistent and predictable routines, 'rules' that they know will be the same whichever adult is with them in school.

These are some of the things that we are introducing.

- 1. We always line up in register order.
- Every class will start the morning with an Early Morning Activity
   Whoever reaches a door first, adult or children, will hold it open Whoever reaches a door first, adult or children, will hold it open for the next person.
- 4. We will also be making sure that everyone is wearing school uniform correctly. If you are finding it difficult to afford any of the items please do contact the office, we have plenty of clean good quality second hand items.

I am also asking for your help at KS2. In the mornings you will see the adult for each class come out to the children who are standing in register order. If your child is anxious or nervous and needs to stand with you for a little longer than other children, can you please help by watching out for the adult and when they appear at the front of the class line, can you send your child over to join them please. This really helps us to set the tone for the day by getting the children to start by moving into school following the ABC.

Finally, I would like to say congratulations to Mrs Mohiuddin. She has been looking to widen her school experience and will be starting a new job in January working in a Year 5 class. We will miss her very much, she has been working with us since 2012. I will be posting the advert to our Facebook page, please help us out by sharing it.
