Dear Parents & Carers,

This week we were pleased to be able to invite Kenny Arnold from People for People into school. This is a group that supports people and families in Stevenage through donations of money, time or items. The message of the assembly was all about community, how the People for People page is a way to get those who can help in touch with those who need it. This year, like many other Stevenage primary schools, we will be taking part in the Reverse Advent Calendar, you will have received a letter explaining it in more detail. Briefly, it is about bringing in an item of food if you are able and then donating it to those who need it. When Kenny Arnold left he commented on how well behaved our children were, how well they listened and about the well thought out answers that they gave. It is always a pleasure to hear about how impressed visitors are when they meet our children.

I visited Year 3 this week and ended up staying to learn all about skeletons. The children learnt all about the names of the different parts of the skeleton. At the end of the lesson I talked to them about what they knew now that they didn't know before, they told me the names of some new bones, they knew which was the longest bone in the body and that babies aren't born with a patella. As I was leaving the lesson I heard the question being asked 'are teeth bones?' I hope to be able to get back into Y3 next week to find out the answer.

As we begin to hire out areas of the school to local classes and groups it brings us some new opportunities into school. Most recently I have been talking to Mimic Stage School who will be running a class for older children here at Ashtree. Because of this we have been offered some free workshops in school, alongside the music and PE opportunities that we have running already this will give the children a new skill or hobby that they can try out. I look forward to letting you know more about this when it starts up.
