

To commemorate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee there is an additional Bank Holiday on Friday 3 June 2022



The DfE have amended the Education (School Day and School Year) (England) Regulations to reduce the 2021/22 school year for maintained schools by one day to account for this additional Bank Holiday. This reduces the number of pupil contact days from 190 to 189.

As 3 June 2022 falls during the Summer Half-term, we are required to amend our published term dates to identify another day of holiday elsewhere in the year. We will be taking this Bank Holiday on Tuesday 19 April 2022, making the first day of term now Wednesday 20 April 2022.

Outside of School Achievement:



Elena and Nella had a busy karate weekend which started in Guildford with a GKR Southern Regional Tournament, Nella won gold in both Kumite (point fighting) and Kata (series of moves performed in a pattern) in a mixed male and female division of 4 competitors. Elena who was unlucky at the last tournament was in a division with 6 other girls, on course for a gold medal in Kata, Elena chose to do a more difficult kata and made a mistake which ultimately cost her a medal but, in the Kumite part she put in a good display narrowly missing out on first place but receiving a silver medal.

On Sunday both Elena and Nella attended the monthly grading at their karate club and graded to the rank of 4th Kyu red belt, recognised as the first senior grade at the club, only 3 more grades to go before they can go for their black belt.


