The English advisor was looking at Reading with Mrs Cox, they were able to look at how much progress we have made since our last Ofsted visit. Both Mrs Cox and the English advisor were very impressed with the teaching of reading and the sense of enjoyment from the children. Over the last two years we have worked hard to further develop the reading teaching and curriculum and I am proud that this progress could be seen.

The Maths advisor worked with Mr Yates looking at how successfully our teaching addresses the areas that teachers are identifying need to be practiced by the children, to really secure their knowledge and understanding. Mr Yates was very pleased with the way that your children are working during their Maths and Fluency sessions and are able to make links in their learning and understanding.

Mr Lawson, Chair of Governors, and our School Improvement advisor came in to look at behaviour around the school and learning behaviours in class. Although this is a time of year when timetables change and Christmas performances are being practiced, the children as always were amazing. They showed how the 'ABC' of walking around the school has been learnt and remembered by everyone. They spoke to our visitors about the ways that the school help them and everyone to behave and to learn. It was a pleasure to show the visitors around the school.

Finally, I am very pleased to say that following Mrs Holtom passing her teaching qualification she will be joining us as the class teacher on a Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in Nursery from January. It makes me very proud that Ashtree Primary School & Nursery supports our community members to develop, grow and be a vital part of the Ashtree School journey. Mrs Rodford will remain with us working with Mrs Holtom.
