


**NEWSLETTER 14**

As we mentioned last week Mrs Barber will be leaving us and Mrs Khan will be joining us from January and the children have meet her this week.


Finally, I would like to wish you all happiest of Christmas breaks where you stay well and safe and the children return rested in January.

Activities will be running in different venues across the county for children and young people aged between 5-16 years, and all include a nutritious meal each day.


