Dear Parents & Carers,

This week I have been able to visit some of your children's classrooms and I have had some children coming to visit me. I spent a very enjoyable 20 minutes listening to the stories that some of the girls in Magpies class came to read to me. They had been reading where the Wild Things are and had written a similar story themselves. They were very confident when they read to me and I was very impressed by their stories. They were using their senses to describe characters and events in the story.

I have also been into Y5 and seen the children working hard on spreadsheets, they were using their knowledge of percentages and using some of the Chrome books that we received during lockdown to work in pairs. The children showed excellent working behaviours, and impressive computing skills. Their learning objective was to create a table of data on a spreadsheet with totals.

I met the Parrots class today as they were walking around the school with a 'map' finding the different areas of the school. They were busy trying to find where the office and the dining room were when I met them. They had already talked about the name of our school and the fact that we are in Stevenage.

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Outside Achievement:


Layla Red Kites won a football tournament with her football team Bedwell Rangers U12s Devils at the weekend, they played against 4 other teams.
