When I walk into the dining room I can hear conversation between younger and older children and they are



always keen to hear my view. We also have added to the older children serving their own puddings and drinks by having water jugs on the tables.

One of the things that I appreciate is staff giving up their time to our lunchtimes and afterschool clubs. On Friday after school I was able to join Mrs Cox's Netball Club, where the children were learning about footwork and passing. I was impressed with Mrs Cox's knowledge which allows our children to experience this sport. I know that Mrs Cox in turn appreciates help she gets from Mrs Cook (a parent) and Megan which supports her to run this club.

If you feel that you have a skill that could be shared with the children, as a regular club or a one off, please let us know. If your child comes home with a slip for a club or an activity can you please return it to let us know if they will be attending or not. Thank you.

I have been contacted this week by parents who are concerned about pedestrian safety both within the car park and at the front of the school. I have also been contacted by local residents who are unable to get their cars out of their driveway. We regularly review which cars can drive onto the school site, if you do not have a pass please do not put us in a difficult position by driving onto the school site. If you do have a pass you should not be driving quickly and it is your responsibility as the driver to ensure pedestrians are safe. If you park in Chertsey Rise this is very busy road at peak times, please do not stop in the entrance to the school or in front of driveways. If you are walking along Chertsey Rise or sending your children to walk or ride to school, please support us by repeating road safety messages given in school. We cannot change the layout of the road or the car park so we all need to keep each other safe. Please do support us by voicing your concerns about Chertsey Rise to Hertfordshire County Council.
