We will still be asking visitors to the school to wear a mask if they are able to, this will help to keep everyone safe now that we will not be testing.

Something that is very important to us here at Ashtree is that we are able to support parents and carers with questions, problems and concerns. Now that making appointments with staff face to face is much easier, I want to remind you of the best people to help resolve your concerns and questions.

The class teacher should always be your first point of contact, they are best placed to support you with the things that happen day to day. They are in the classroom with your children and speak to the MSAs about lunchtimes, this means that they can quickly answer questions and resolve problems. They know your children best out of all of the adults in the school.

If you feel that you need to escalate, a question or concern once you have spoken to the class teacher then we have phase leaders throughout the school. Miss Sinnott is EYFS lead, Mrs McQueen is KS1 lead, Mrs Cox Lower KS2 lead and Miss Kiernan upper KS2 lead. The easiest way to make an appointment to see these members of staff is through the office.

The Senior Leadership Team are always here to help should you feel that the matter is confidential, or you have spoken with the phase leaders and want to escalate it further. Mr Yates is Assistant Head, Ms Ruprai is Deputy Head and then myself as Headteacher. Again, the best way to make an appointment is through the office.

We have also been looking at streamlining our office procedures recently, we are a large school site and hand delivered messages are not always the most efficient way of doing this. Moving forward, if you have a message about your child, particularly a change in collection arrangements, please phone the school office where they will take a message and pass this electronically to the relevant staff. We will also contact you to confirm that it was you that phoned in, this gives us an additional way to keep your children safe. The confirmation will be sent through SchoolComms.





