Dear Parents & Carers,

This week I have been contacted by a couple of parents asking for some information to be shared in the newsletter.

<u>Swimming</u> following the Ofsted inspection we began to evaluate our timetable, both the weekly timetable and the yearly timetable. One of the things we noticed was that the way that swimming was organised was not time effective and that a much better way to organise this was to change the time of year and the year group where the children had swimming lessons. Swimming and water safety are an important part of the curriculum and are something that we will be reviewing over the next year. Swimming will now take place in Y6 during the second half of the Summer term, the current Year 6's are the first year group to have missed some of the swimming that they would have had in Y4. Going forward all children will get the opportunity to swim when in Y6 and water safety will be taught in early years.

<u>Bike helmets</u> We all know that wearing a helmet when on our bikes is important, but did you know that a recent study found that wearing a helmet reduced the odds of suffering a head injury by 51 per cent, a serious head injury by 69 per cent and a fatal head injury by 65 per cent. One of our Year 6's recently fell off his bike and the injuries were quite worrying to look at. You will be pleased to hear that he is ok, but it is a timely reminder to us all of the importance of wearing a Helmet.

Ofsted update We are still working hard to develop the key areas of the report, one of these is curriculum. Last term I spoke about how we were developing the Science, History and Art curriculum, this is well underway, and staff across the school are using the plans this term in their teaching. We have now started the same process with Geography, Computing and DT and I am sure there will be some more updates soon on this. We are also moving at a good pace with the reading and phonics development. We have our new resources for the Little Wandle programme in school and the staff are keen to get started with the initial assessment tools. We have also started ordering books that are correctly book matched to the phonics programme.

Finally we are fully expecting to be having a restriction free sports day this year and enjoying being back to normal. More information will follow as the finer details are organised and decided.
