This week I have been talking with the children about their learning. During assembly on Friday, I will be reminding them about some of the things that help us learn from the lists I spoke about in last week's newsletter.

I also had the pleasure of talking to Year 5 and Year 6 about their learning, the teachers can be very proud of what they are doing in class because the children were so excited about learning. They spoke to me about how much the Working Walls in class help them to remember the facts that they have learnt or the methods they have used. They are finding the widgets that we are using to illustrate key vocabulary really helps them to remember the words.

They mentioned how helpful their teachers and the teaching assistants are and that the way the adults teach, and model work makes them enjoy challenging themselves because they feel that they are so well explained. We also spoke about handwriting and how much they are enjoying the new handwriting interventions. They were even keen to tell me and show me their favourite letters to write!

It was a joy to speak to children that were so polite, well-spoken, and enthusiastic about their learning.
