Dear Parents & Carers,

This week staff at Ashtree have been busy organising the EYFS and KS1 open evenings for September 2024 starters. We will be opening our doors to view Nursery, Reception and KS1 Wednesday 1 November between 3:30pm and 5:00pm. This is a chance for parents who have children that will be starting Nursery or Reception in September 2024 to see what we have to offer. I hope that Sunbeams will also be open to show parents the preschool provision available. When the information is posted to our Facebook page, please do share it, and help us to welcome as many potential parents as possible and show them a school environment that we are proud of.

I have been walking around classrooms this week and have to say that I am very proud of the children for the way that they are settling into the new class routines and showing me good learning behaviours when I come in. The older children have been setting an excellent example of how to behave in assembly and teaching the younger children for whom this is their first time in a whole school assembly.

I know that some of the House Point postcards have started to arrive at home, the children have been very excited about receiving them and are trying hard to earn more 'on the spot' house points and have another card arrive through the door. on the spot house points are awarded for outstanding behaviour, this might be in work, friendships, behaviour, or manners.



I visited Reception and Nursery this week and they were totally engaged in the activities during Child Initiated Learning. In particular I was impressed with Sahara who built a model of the tower in the town centre using the materials in the classroom.

I have seen some lovely examples of problem solving and community this week including the children using and enjoying the trail that the staff had left out for them to explore. Year 6 monitors taking on their role and responsibility very seriously, setting out chairs for assembly, supporting younger children log on to computers and lots more.

Ms Ruprai, Mr Yates and I have been talking and planning ideas for extending the rewards in school and so keep a look out for some new cups and awards on their way.

Here at Ashtree we understand that music plays a key role in brain development. It helps with the nurturing of language, motor skills, emotional intelligence, and collaboration skills. This is why we are invested in creating positive and fruitful musical experiences.

Children have given lots of positive feedback about having their music lessons and clubs in our dedicated music room. Lylah (Hawks) says 'I like how there are lots of instruments in there and we can use the ear defenders if we need to.'

Charlie (Eagles) said 'there's more space to move when singing and playing instruments.'

Weekly Violin lessons have now started for Red Kites and Kestrels (other classes will follow later in the year). If your child is interested in having a 1:1 violin lesson in school with our teacher, you can sign up at hertsmusicservice.org.uk. Other instrumental and vocal lessons are also available at Ashtree school via the Hertfordshire Music service.
