Woodland Walk – Mrs Cox

In January of this year, I was delighted to take Ashtree Eco Councillors to Fairlands Valley Park, to plant trees for a new community woodland.

Last Friday morning, I took many of these same councillors, as well as our Science Leads and Eco Leads back to Fairlands Valley Park to see the official naming of this new woodland and to take part in activities related to our local environment.

The pupils were very excited to see the Mayor of Stevenage unveil the name and reveal it to be Fairlane Wood. We then began the three activities we would take part in.

First, we learned more about the trees in Stevenage, as we were led through a different woodland by Christian. He explained how Stevenage Council look after the trees in the area and he taught us how to identify different trees.

Next, we learnt about different birds of prey, and we even had the opportunity to hold them.

Finally, we learned about the seeds from the trees and about other plant and wildlife in the woods, as we walked through the Millenium Woodland with Pat and Andy. We found different seeds on our walk and planted them in pots, ready to grow our own trees at home.

It was a wonderful opportunity for Ashtree to be a part of this community event and once again, Ashtree pupils showed themselves to be enthusiastic learners and amazing ambassadors for our school.
