Prior skills - EYFS:

- 1. To recognise the importance of saying sorry and forgiveness
- 2. To recognise that all families are different
- 3. Identify different members of the family
- 4. Understand how members of a family can help each other

Prior knowledge:

- 1. Know that friendships can make us feel happy
- 2. Know some ways that we can make new friends feel welcome
- 3. Know that arguing with friends and then making up can make friendships stronger
- 4. That resorting to violence is never right

Key Knowledge:

- 1. To understand that we are all different but can still be friends
- 2. Know that we can be friends with people who are different to us
- 3. Understand that babies need care and support
- 4. Know that older children can do more by themselves
- 5. Know there are different types of families
- 6. Know which people we can ask for help

Key Skills:

- 1. To discuss how children grow and change
- 2. To explore different types of families and who to ask for help
- 3. To identify who can help when families make us feel unhappy or unsafe

Future Knowledge:

- 1. To introduce the concept of gender stereotypes
- 2. Understand that some people have fixed ideas about what boy and girls can do
- 3. Understand how males and females are part of the lifecycle
- 4. Understand that making a new life needs a male and a female
- 5. To focus on sexual difference and name body parts
