Computing – Year 2 – Digital Literacy (including online safety)

Key Vocabulary

Sharing, internet, e-mail, attachment, digital footprint

Key Knowledge

Children can be taught key knowledge by following the steps below:

- 1. Re-cap previous online safety work. When have pupils learnt this before? What do they already know? Can they recall the story, *Hanni and the Magic Window,* from Safer Internet Day? Which adults can we tell if we need help?
- 2. Use Purple Mash Online Safety lessons, unit 2.2.
 - Step 1 To search and share safely.
 - Step 2 To begin to understand how to communicate with others electronically
 - Step 3 To begin to learn about our digital footprint

Prior Knowledge

- Pupils can access age-appropriate software.
- Pupils begin to learn to keep private information safe online.
- Pupils learn to be cautious when online and to check with an adult before sharing information online.
- Pupils know how to report inappropriate online content.

Key Skills

- Pupils begin to learn the implications of inappropriate online searches.
- Pupils know how to report inappropriate online content.
- Pupils explore websites and say whether they like them or not.
- Pupils are introduced to the concept of sending messages via the internet using a class e-mail account.
