Year 3 Spring Term 30 -minute sessions

Prior Knowledge - Autumn Term Year 3

- Practise and embed key phonics sounds.
- Greet each other in French.
- Label nouns (items in pencil case)
- Sing in French (Christmas song)

Prior Skills -Autumn Year 3

- Familiarity with early phonics sounds
- Able to converse in simple sentences
- Able to follow the words in a song and express what the lyrics mean.

Lessons

- Step 1 -To learn key classroom language.
- Step 2 -To learn new nouns with the indefinite article.
- Step 3 To learn how to make nouns plural in French
- Step 4 To learn how to say "a" and "some" and change to "the".
- Step 5 To learn the adjectives of colour.
- Step 6 To listen and read along.
- Step 7-To describe animals with colours.
- Step 8 To join in with a song about animals.
- Step 9 -Listen and read along
- Seps 10/11 -To develop the ability to listen attentively to a passage with familiar and unfamiliar words.

Key Skills:

- Step 1 -silence, prenez un stylo, un volontaire, ouvrez vos cashiers, regardez, ecoutez, ecrivez
- Step 2 chat, Chien, poisson, oiseau. canard, cheval, mouton, ours, grenouille
- Step 3 Nouns as above (animal plurals) with 's' (or nothing, or '(au)x' added).
- Step 4 Articles animals change: un, une, des, le, la, les
- Step 5 bleu, rouge, blanc, noir, vert, jaune, marron, violet, orange, gris.
- Step 6 Brown Bear Story or another similar story
- Step 7- Listen, read and describe pictures.
- Step 8- Sing Old MacDonald or other similar animal song.
- Step 9- Repeat Brown Bear story focusing on fluency of reading or choose another similar
- Steps 10/11 Additional stories and songs

Phonics sounds:

- -ez as in regardez, ecoutez, ecrivez, prenez, croisez, ouvrez
- -ch as in cheval

- -eu as in bleu
- -anc as in blanc
- -es as in des, es as in les
