

Ashtree Primary School and Nursery Medium Term Plan for French

Year 4 Spring Term 30 -minute sessions

Prior Knowledge – Autumn Term Year 4

- Practise and embed key phonics sounds.
- Revision of vocabulary related to greetings, numbers, and seasons.
- Spoken French -ask questions and answer questions relating to birthdays
- Learn and use typical French expressions.
- Listen and follow a video with unfamiliar vocabulary.

Prior Skills -Autumn Year 4

- Pronounce phonic sounds correctly.
- Build up a word bank of vocabulary related to numbers, seasons, birthdays and Christmas.
- Able to converse in simple sentences.
- Able to ask and answer questions in French.
- Able to follow the words in a song and express what the lyrics mean.

Lessons

Step 1 -To learn the names for key shapes.

Step 2 -To combine colour and other adjectives with shapes to describe shapes.

Step 3 – To learn how to describe where things are in a picture.

Step 4 – To use learned language to describe a picture to another person or class.

Step 5 – To create own picture with a written description and share with others.

Steps 6 /7– To learn nouns for parts of the face and use them in spoken sentences.

Step 8 To combine adjectives and nouns to describe faces and use them in spoken and written sentences.

Step 9/10 – To learn the nouns for parts of the body and label and show.

Step 11 -Design and describe a monster picture. Use the language of description learned in earlier lessons.

Step 2 - Shapes & colours

Step 4 - Describing Matisse pictures: Use language from lessons 1,2,3

Step 5 - Create own picture: Use language from lessons 1,2,3

Steps 6 /7 -le visage, les yeux, le nez, les cheveux, les dents, la bouche, la langue,

Step 8- Parts of the face & adjectives -language as above

Step 9- Parts of the body: la tête, les épaules, le bras, le coude, la main, le doigt, la jambe, le genou, le pied, l'estomac

Step 10- Parts of the body continued

Step 11 -Designing & describing monster pictures
