Year 6 Summer Term – Drugs and alcohol

Prior Knowledge -Year 5:

- To know about a range of legal and illegal drugs
- To have some understanding of the effects and risks of illegal drugs
- To explore attitudes to drug use
- To understand that all sorts of people may misuse drugs

Prior skills - Year 5:

1. To explore a range of legal and illegal drugs, their risks and effects
 - 1.1 To have considered attitudes and beliefs about drug use and drug users
2. To challenge myths about drug use
3. To have considered strategies to resist drug use
 - 3.1 To develop some assertiveness skills

Key Knowledge :

- To know what effect cannabis can have on your health and life
- To know the legal consequences of using cannabis
- To know the effects and risks of volatile substance abuse
- To know how to get and to give help
- To know how to access help and support

Key Skills:

1. To understand the effects, risks and law relating to cannabis
2. To understand the risk of volatile substance abuse (VSA)
3. To be aware of the options for getting help, advice and support
 - 3.1 To have practised communicating with adults

Future Knowledge:

- analyse their attitudes and beliefs about the prevalence
- of drug use amongst young people
- assess the reasons why young people might choose to
- use or not use drugs
- explain the legal terms 'possession', 'supply' and 'intent to supply' in relation to drugs
- explain the short- and long-term legal consequences of being found in possession of, using, selling or supplying different classes of drugs
